Terms and Conditions for Lecturers

Air Fare: Unless you are specifically advised in advance, it is your responsibility to arrange and pay your air transportation to and from the port.

Visas: All passengers must travel with a valid passport. Immigration and entry visa requirements are subject to change at any time, and it is the responsibility of the guest to obtain all necessary documentation required for travel to each port included in the cruise itinerary. Contact Zierer Visa Service at www.zvs.com for specific country requirements.

Baggage/Personal Belongings: Your personal baggage should not exceed the international/domestic air carrier weight restrictions. The Director is responsible for any costs associated with excess baggage. Princess does not accept responsibility for the damage to or loss of personal belongings.

Co-Hosting Private Parties: On occasion, the Lecturers may be required to co-host private parties for the passengers.

Dress/Conduct: The Lecturers are required to act in a professional manner at all times and to conform to the vessel's dress code. In addition, the Lecturers are required to socialize with passengers in a manner that would be appropriate for a representative of Princess.

Insurance: Medical and travel insurance are not provided to the Lecturers. Additionally, Princess does not assume responsibility for accidents or illnesses that may occur on board. However, you may obtain travel and medical cruise insurance from your travel agency.

Ground Transportation: You are responsible for your ground transportation to and from the airport and cruise ship terminal.

Money Games: Per Princess Cruises policy, you are prohibited from participating in casino activities or jackpot games such as bingo or horseracing. You are permitted to play the slot machines.

Tours: You may request to be an escort on available Shore Excursions. The Tour Office will determine the need and assignments of escorts. If you are not selected as an escort, you may purchase the tour depending on space availability.

Travel Documentation/Immunizations: The Lecturer is responsible for obtaining valid travel documents such as passports, visas, vaccination/immunization certificates and any other health documents needed to enter and leave the base port and other ports where the ship may call.

Responsibilities: A Lecturer shall conduct himself/herself consistent with the highest moral and ethical standards so as not to offend the individuals onboard. You must also agree to abide by the orders of the ship's Captain and Officers and comply with all rules of the ship, including mandatory attendance at lifeboat drills.

Cancellation Policy: Kindly note that cruise lines, like airlines, sometimes overbook. Although it is a rare occurrence, Princess reserves the right to cancel a lecturer at any given time for a variety of reasons. Sixth Star is not responsible for any cancellation of lecturers by Princess.

Unacceptable Behavior: Princess Cruises follows a very strict conduct policy. Therefore, a Lecturer is required to act in a professional manner at all times and abide by all rules and guidelines set forth by the Captain and the cruise line. These include the following:

- Lecturer shall not carry or consume any illegal narcotics or drugs, except those pursuant to a program of medical care under the direct supervision of the ship's doctor.
- The consumption of alcoholic beverages aboard the vessel to the point of intoxication or to the point where such consumption could become apparent to the passengers is prohibited. This includes boarding the ship in an intoxicated state without the consent of the Captain.
- Lecturer shall not sell any merchandise to passengers or purchase merchandise from the vessel's shops for resale.
- A Lecturer shall not make undue noise in his/her accommodations.
- A Lecturer shall not bring any firearm or other weapon onto the vessel.

Princess shall have the right to immediately remove any Lecturer whose conduct fails to comply with the Captain's standing orders, the Company policy, or is not suited to serve in this position. If for any reason, you terminate your length of assignment or are asked to leave by Princess, you will be responsible to pay your own transportation home.
