Airport – Port Transfer Information
San Juan, Puerto Rico**

The capital of Puerto Rico is a spirited modern metropolis with high-rise beach strips, a major commercial centre and a justly famous historic colonial core. It dates from the early 16th century, making it the second-oldest city in the Americas (after granddaddy Cuzco, Peru). Today it's the engine of the island's economic and political life and the cultural beachhead for US influence in the Caribbean.



AIRPORT INFORMATION

The Luis Munoz Marin International Airport (SJU) is about 9 miles from San Juan, reached by taxi, public bus or rental car.

Parking -- There are no port parking facilities at the Port of San Juan. There are public parking facilities in the area surrounding the port.

TRANSPORTATION

Minibuses -- You can also hail minibuses (called "omnibus"), which shuttle along main routes; to hail one, respond with a wave when the driver toots his horn.

Rental Cars -- Rental car agencies operate out of Condado (about 5 miles from Old San Juan). Hertz (800-654-3131) and Avis (800-831-2847). Uniquely, both agencies will reimburse you for up to a \$5 cab ride.

ACCOMMODATIONS

For cruise passengers embarking or disembarking in San Juan (it's a big home port for southern Caribbean itineraries), here are a couple of hotels in Old San Juan:

The grandest: The El Convento Hotel (100 Calle Cristo, 800-468-2779), a one time Carmelite convent in the 17th century, has long been a hotel but its recent refurbishment puts it in the deluxe category.

The chain hotel: Old San Juan has just one: the Wyndham Old San Juan (100 Brumbaugh St, 800-468-2818), which enjoys the closest proximity to the cruise ship terminal and has a casino.

The funky, chic, quirky hotel: The Gallery Inn (204 Calle Norzagaray, 787-722-1808), facing the Atlantic, is a hodgepodge of historic houses all decorated in the ultimate funky style by its owner-artist. A few tips: there are lots of steps, uneven at that, rooms are small, and you have to specify if you want a window. We told you it was quirky.

**Beyond San Juan for those with a few extra days and a healthy investment portfolio, a couple of nights stay on Puerto Rico's West Coast at the Horned Dorset Primavera (Rincon, 800-633-1857), the island's premier small hotel, is a treasure.
